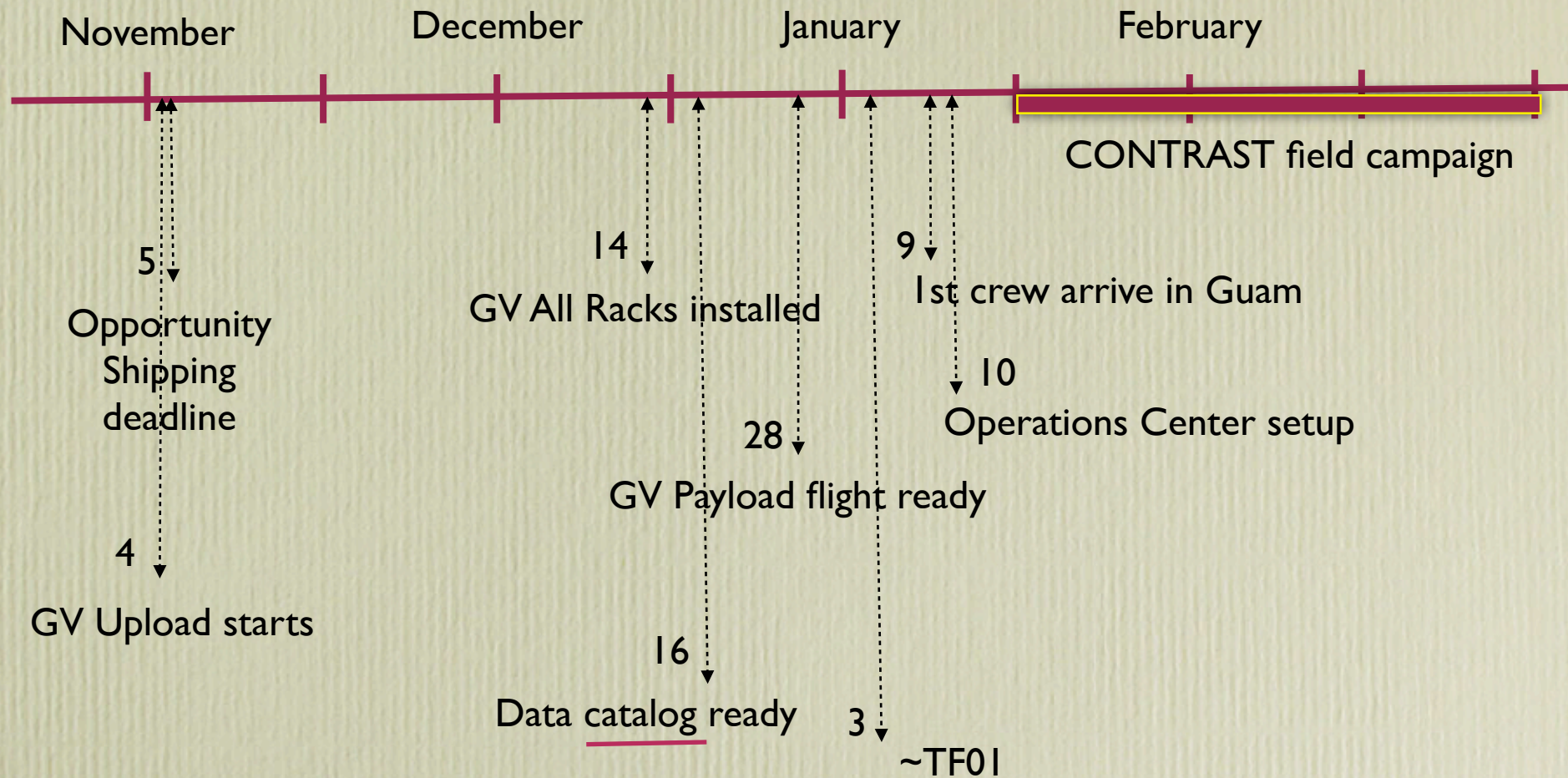

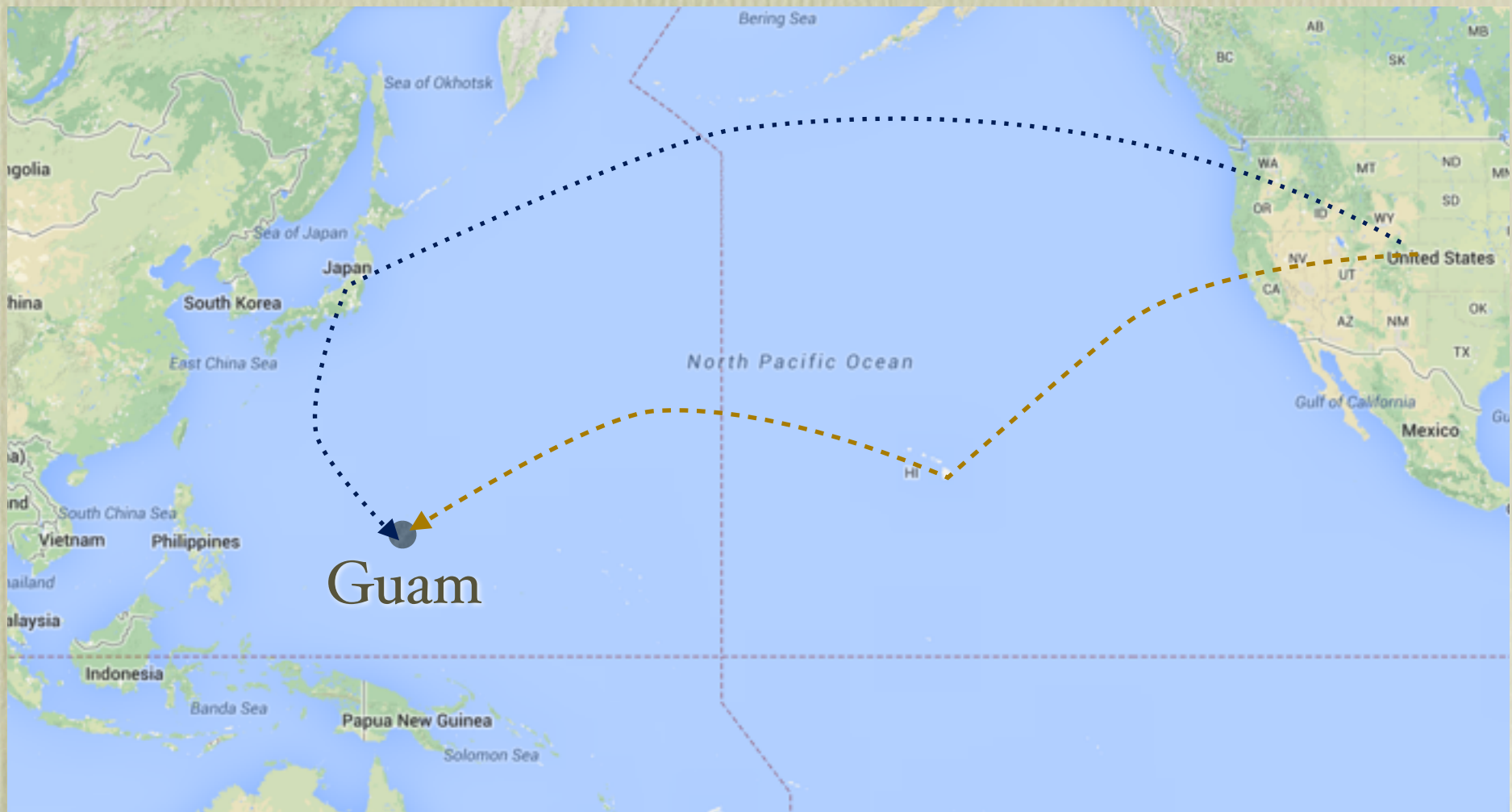

Guam an international destination?

- Guam is a USA Territory,
- Flights to /from Guam to the USA do not require customs clearances or immigration. (there are agricultural checks)
- However!!.. you must carry valid visa, passport, etc.
- If you travel from Japan, or other countries, you will go through customs and immigration upon arrival in Guam.
- Phone - Check with your carrier (generally international rates may apply)
- Me: I have AT&T with free calls to a USA line, but needed an international data package (\$\$\$)

Where are we staying?

- Host hotel is the HILTON GUAM RESORT and SPA
 - Government rate offered to all CONTRAST participants
 - CAST and ATTREX sharing the hotel

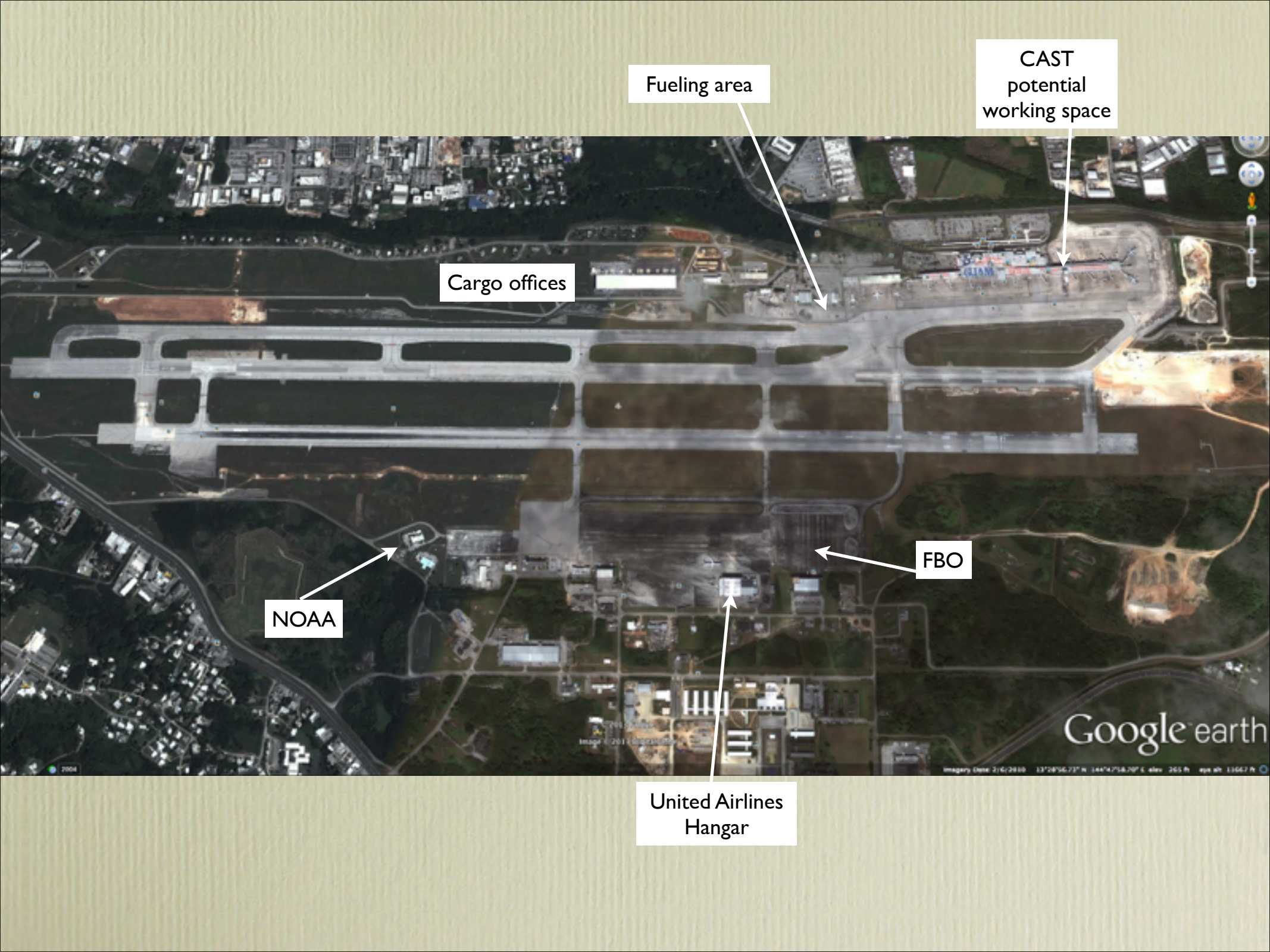

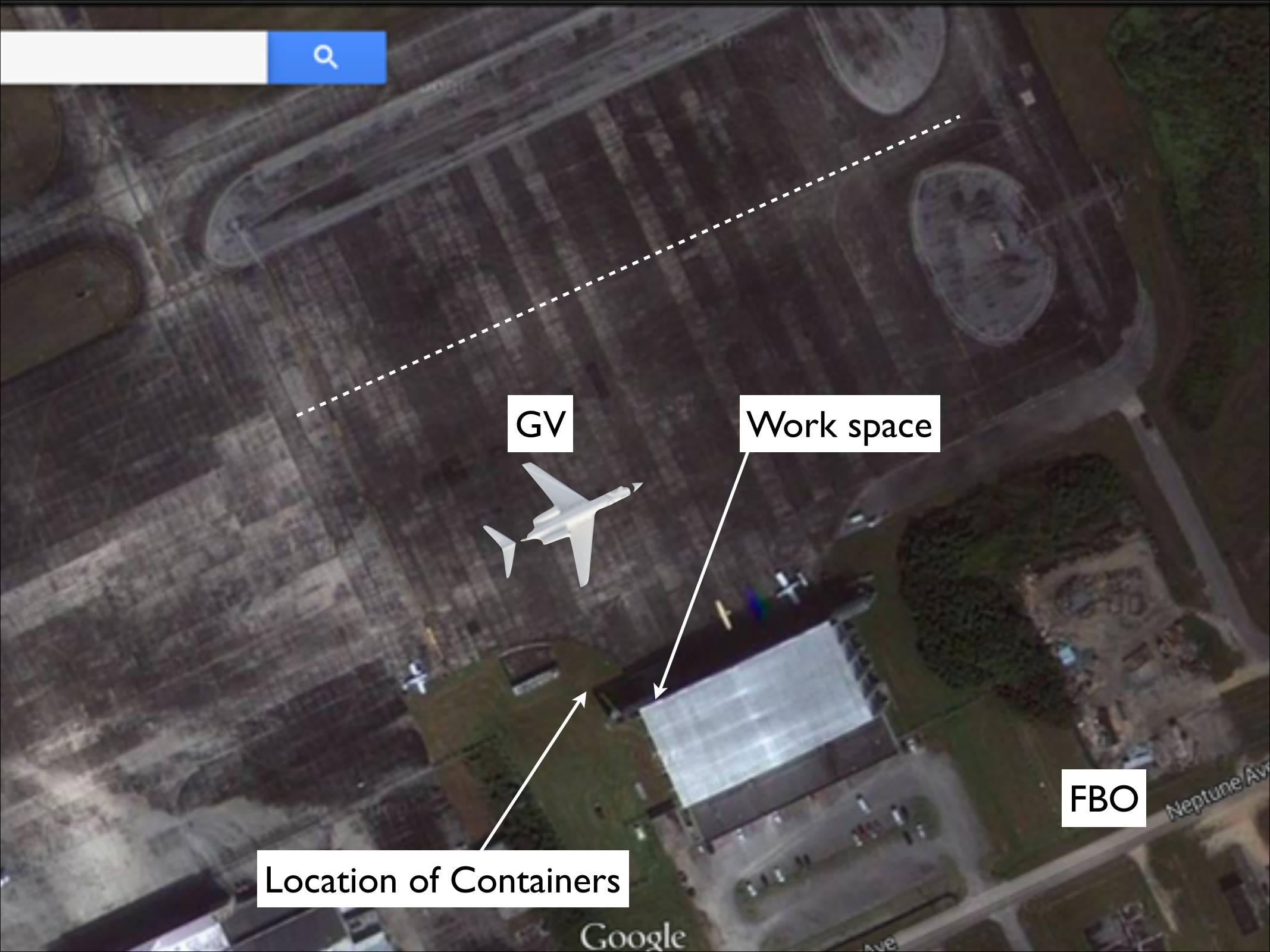


Location of Containers
