

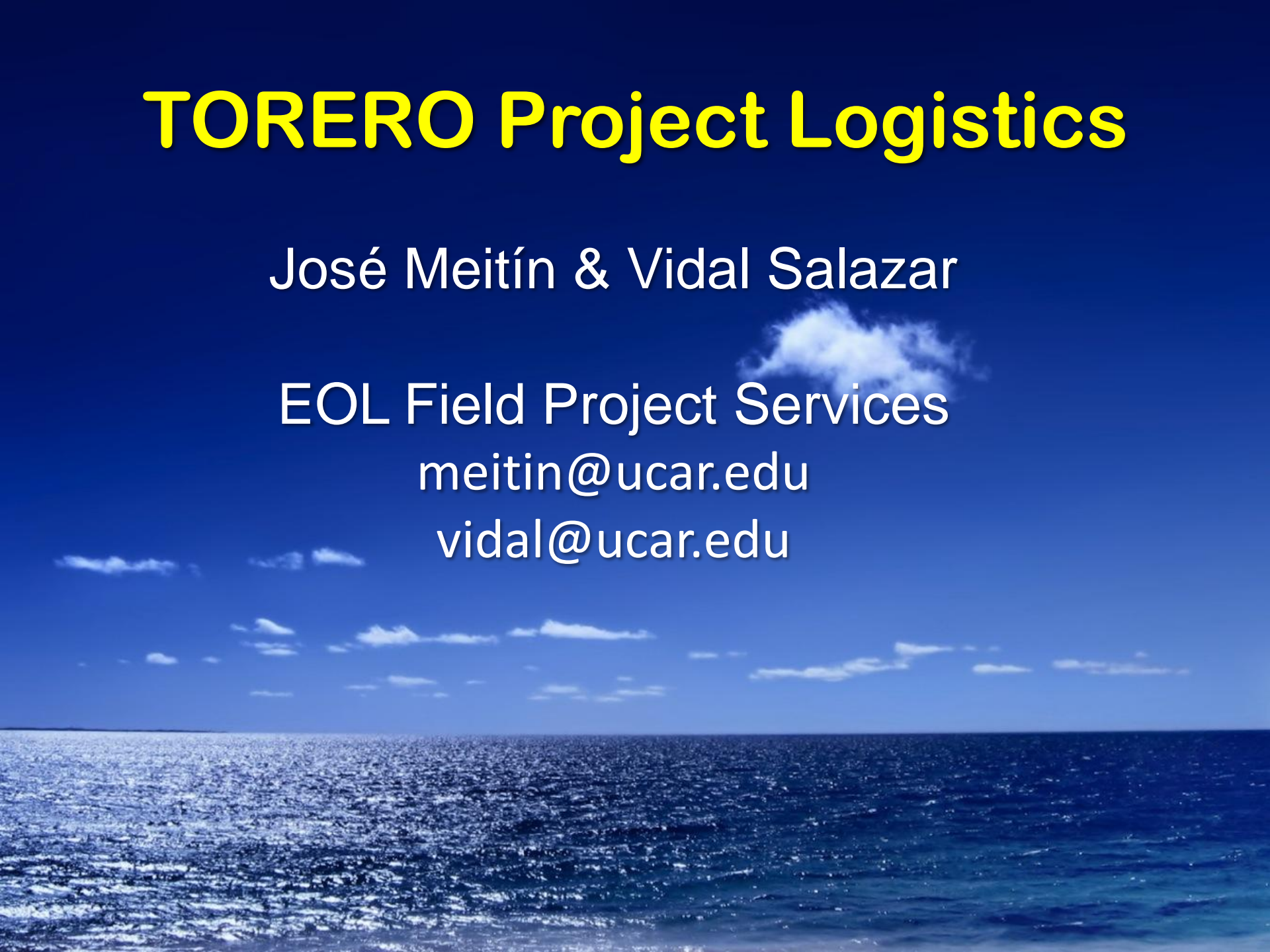

Quick Facts- Costa Rica

- **Population:** 4.5 million
- **Time:** Central Standard Time zone, GMT -6,
- **Electricity:** 110 volts, 60Hz. U.S. standard.
- **Language:** Spanish (but English is widely spoken).
- **Currency:** Colón (~ \$1USD = ₡500 CRC), major credit cards, tourist businesses accept US dollars
- **Telephones:** International Dialing Code **506**
- **Entry requirements for U.S. citizens:** A valid passport is required for entry to Costa Rica.
- **Departure Tax:** \$26 USD

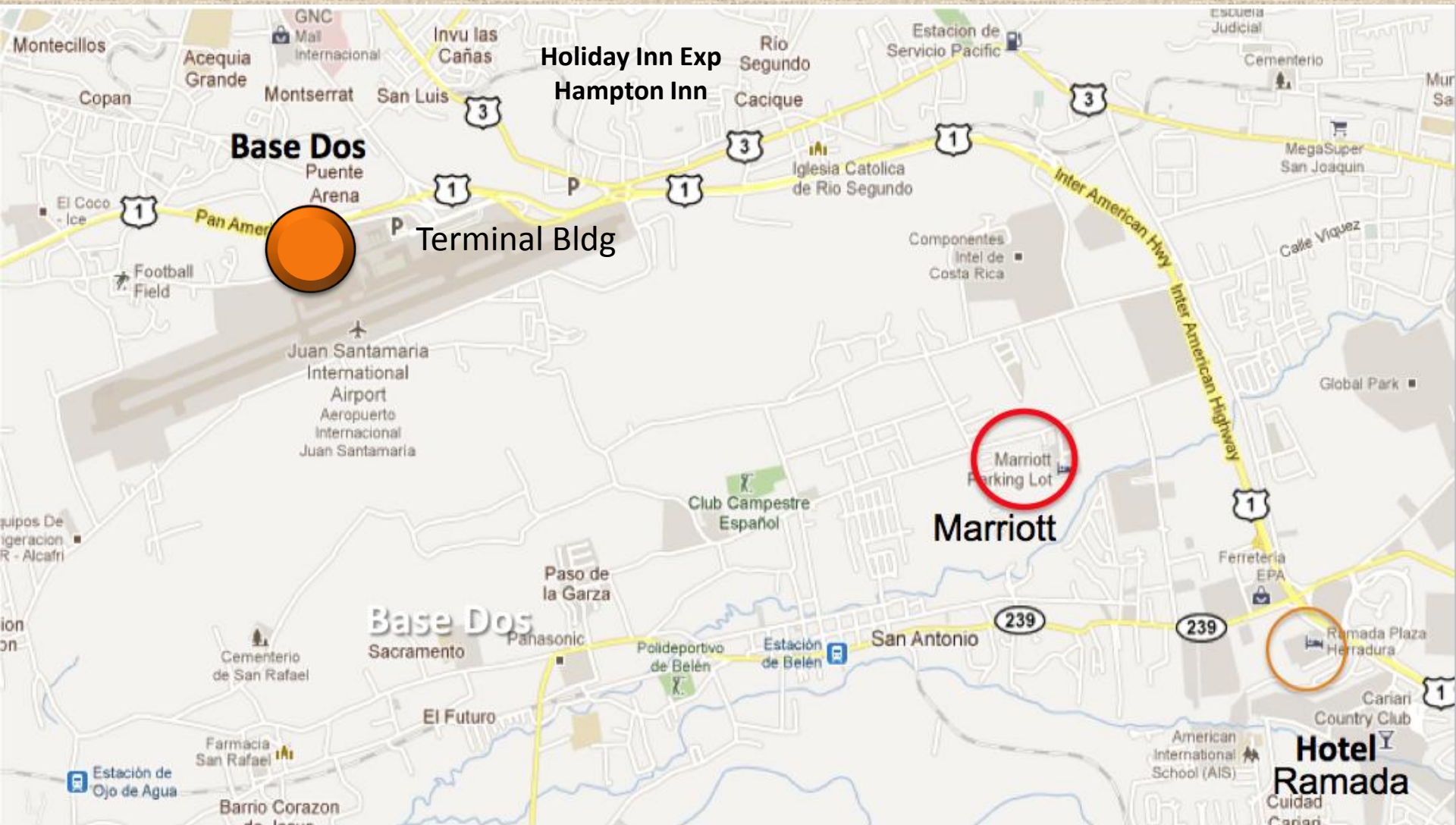

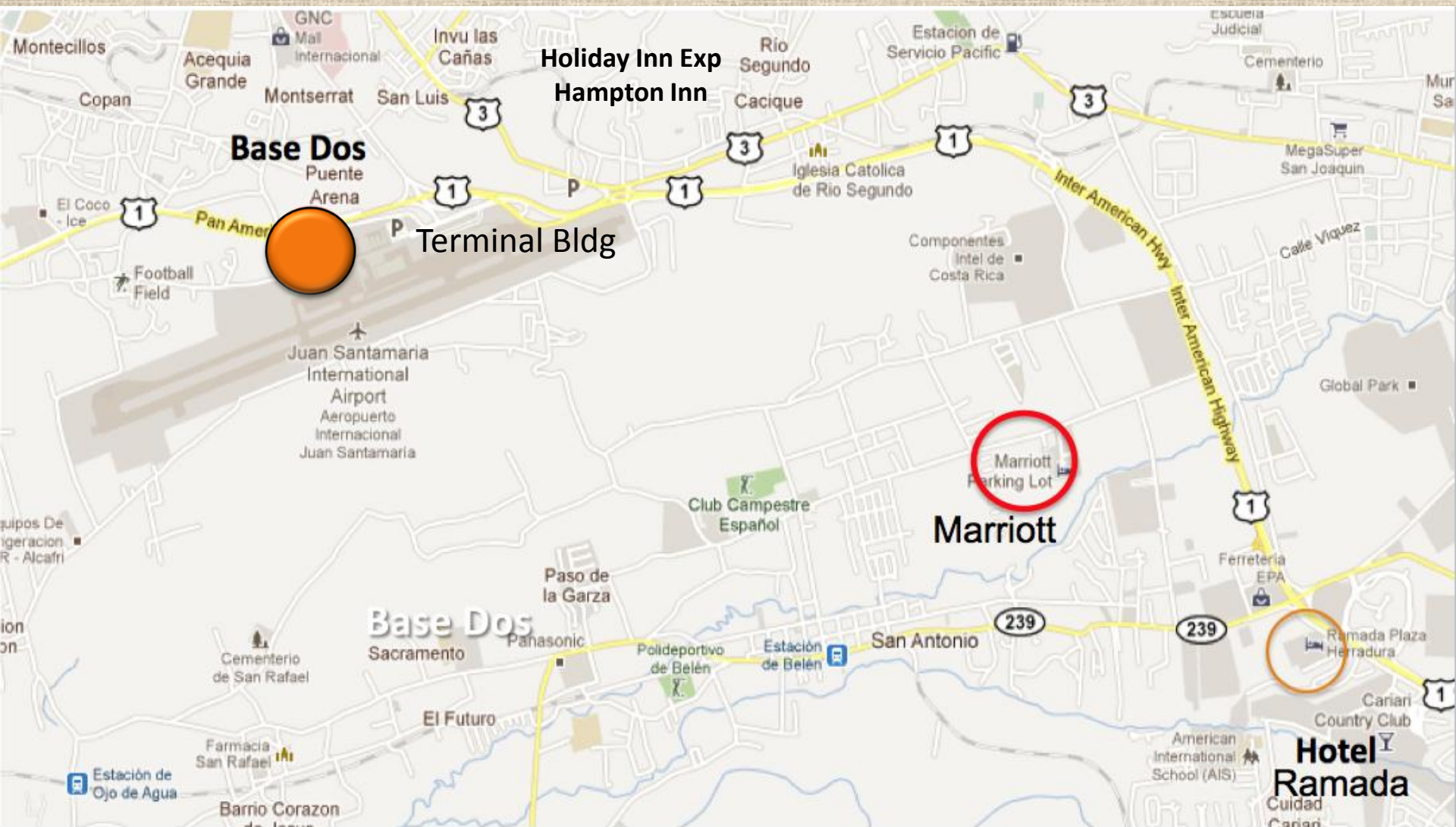

- **Telephones:** International Dialing Code **56**
- **Entry requirements for U.S. citizens:** A valid passport is required for entry to Chile. Reciprocity fee on arrival \$140 USD
- **Departure Tax:** \$18 USD

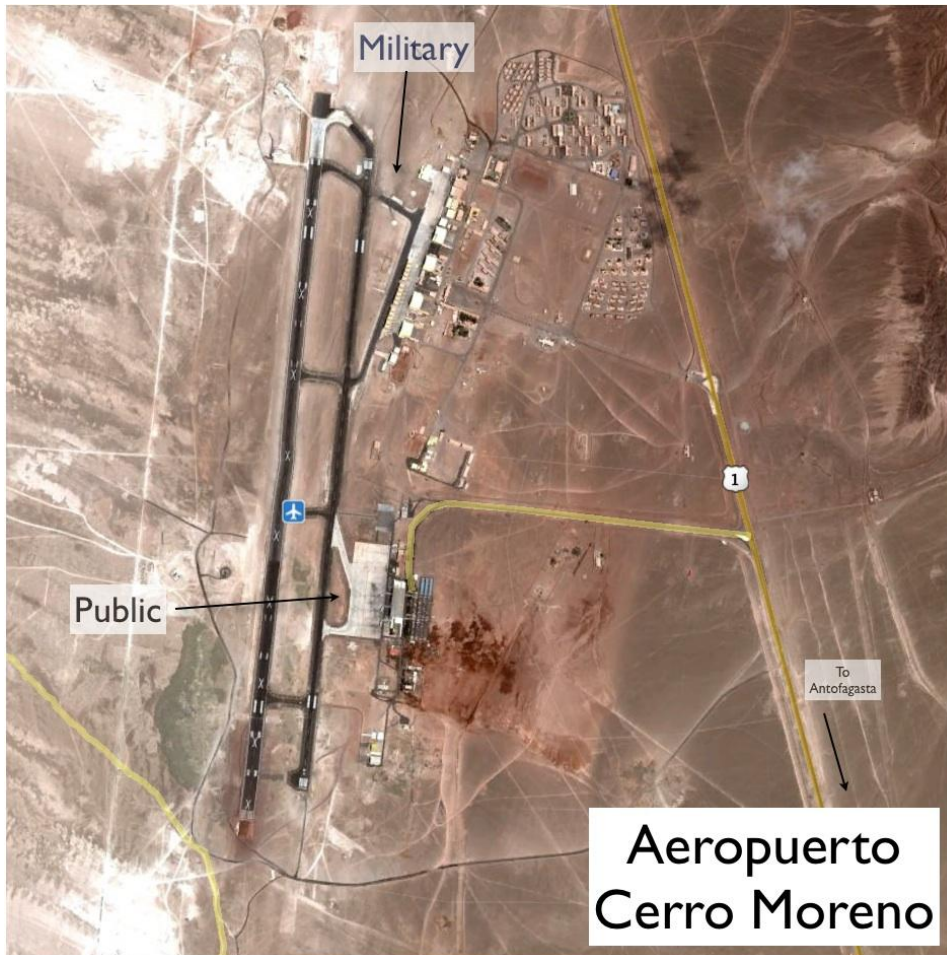
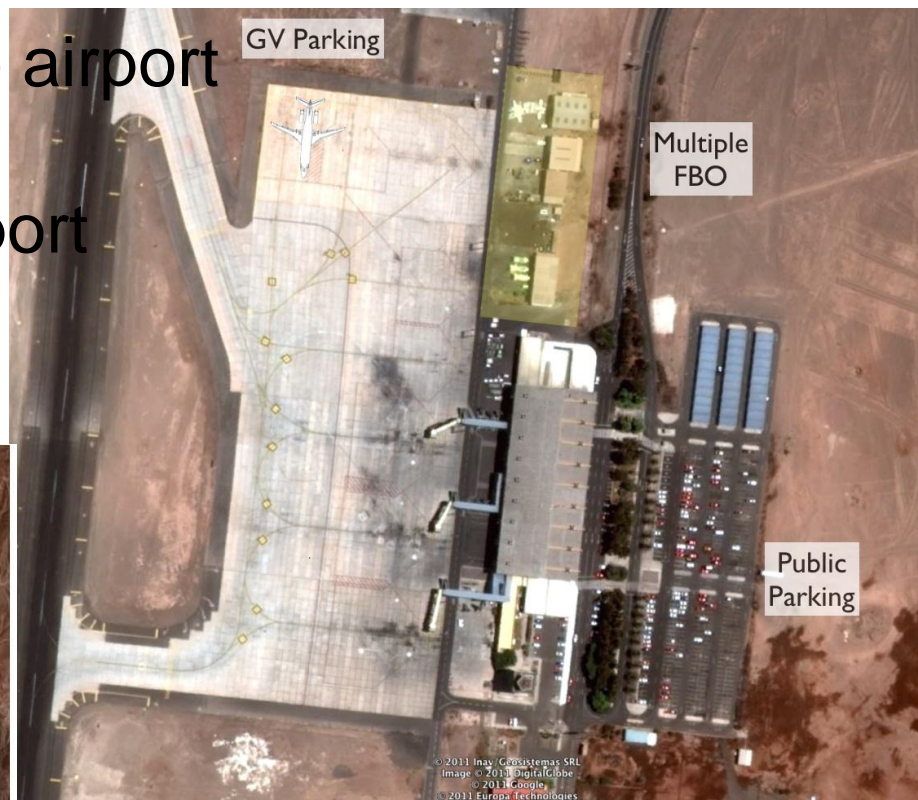
