Worst of all, though, were stories of the various and sundry diseases of West Africa, the White Man's Grave*. Daily, an announcement would come in of more perils to expect, and these we found everywhere, including almost all the literature we could pick up about West Africa.

Black could take no comfort from this title.

Numerous "Helpful" references didn't allay our fears much, either:

"QUITE APART FROM THE SAILORS AND THEIR MISERABLE LIVES ON TRADING STEAMERS, I THINK THAT THERE ARE THOUSANDS OF MILES ALONG THE WEST COAST OF AFRICA UNFIT FOR ANY WHITE MAN TO LIVE FOR ANY LENGTH OF TIME. AS FOR A WHITE WOMAN, IT IS WHAT THE AMERICANS CALL MENTAL CRUELTY TO ASK HER TO RESIDE ANYWHERE ON THE COAST AT ALL. THE MOIST ENERVATING CLIMATE WITH ITS HIGH TEMPERATURE AND HEAVY WINDS, THE APPALLING STENCHES, THE BAD WATER SUPPLY, THE TERRIBLE MONOTONY, THE CONSTANT ASSOCIATION WITH (THE NATIVES), ALL COMBINED WITH THE INEVITABLE MALARIA TO UNDERMINE THE HEALTH AND CONSTITUTION OF ANY WHITE SETTLER. NO ONE COULD LIVE ON THE COAST AT THE TIME OF WHICH I WRITE WITHOUT HIS CHARACTER AND DISPOSITION BEING SERIOUSLY MODIFIED FOR THE WORSE. I ONLY HEARD OF OF MAN THEN, A DOCTOR, LIVING THE REGULATION TWENTY YEARS - HALF OF WHICH WERE SPENT IN EUROPE - TO QUALIFY FOR HIS WELL-EARNED PENSION. SOONER OR LATER, THE COAST DYSCRASIA MANIFESTED ITSELF WITH THE UNMISTAKABLE SALLOW COMPLEXION WHICH IS ALWAYS A FORERUNNER OR EARLY DEATH...."

"OF COURSE IN THE MATTER OF TREATMENT AND DIAGNOSIS, MANY ADVANCES HAVE BEEN MADE WITH REGARD TO TROPICAL DISEASES OF RECENT YEARS, BUT I DON'T BELIEVE THAT IT IS POSSIBLE TO CONVERT ANY STATION ALONG THE WEST AFRICAN COAST INTO A SUFFICIENTLY HEALTHY PLACE FOR EUROPEANS TO LIFE WITHOUT RUNNING SERIOUS DANGERS."

AND FROM <u>RETURN TO LAUGHTER</u>, BY ELENORE SMITH BOWEN (DOUBLE-DAY, NATURAL HISTORY LIBRARY EDITION, NEW YORK, 1964):

"My main trouble (with going to Western Africa) had been that I had no idea of what I might need. My own imagination carried me no further than a typewriter, paper notebooks, and a miscellany for reading: detective stories, desert-island stand-bys like Shakespeare, and the Bible, and a <u>terrifying handbook of tropical diseases...</u>"

 - IS THE URGENCY FACTOR, VARYING LINEARLY TO EX-PONENTIALLY WITH URGENCY.



No one was quite sure what the Senegalese thought of all of this, but the Children obviously enjoyed it. And the African goats reacted like American cows.






