

# Planning Meeting for the S-Pol Deployment at TiMREX

## GENERAL

- Next meeting will be held Wednesday, January 23, 2008 from 10:30-12:00 in the EOL Atrium.

## S-POL PREPARATION

- Scott Ellis and Jim Wilson reviewed the state of CIDD for TiMREX, and made suggestions for changes to Mike Dixon. They also discovered that the calibration for HAWK and VIRAQ produced differences in reflectivity and ZDR.

## SHIPPING

- S-Pol will be shipped on March 21. Shipping will take around 4 weeks which means setup will start on April 21.
- Wen-Chau Lee has arranged to meet the Seajet representative in Taipei on Jan. 21.

## OTHER

- Mike Daniels proposed that we try to use Skype and web based images for project coordination with the CWB in Taipei. He said that this system worked well over the 512 kbit/s link that was used on Christmas Island. For this, we will need to order headset (earphones and microphones) and make sure that the CWB will allow Skype on the 2 Mbit/s link.
