WHO :: Christchurch area Middle and High School Science teachers

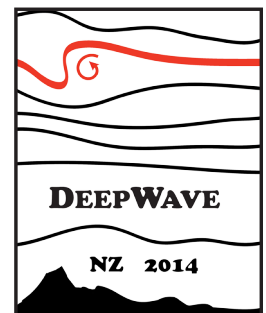
WHAT :: Learn how the weather and climate are studied using both ground-based and airborne instrumentation while getting an in-depth look at a cutting-edge research aircraft
